## Adult Sunday School: Matthew 25 Congregations

Matthew 25:31–46 calls us all to actively engage in the world around us, so that our faith comes alive and we wake up to new possibilities. Convicted by this scripture, the 222<sup>nd</sup> and 223<sup>rd</sup> General Assemblies (2016 and 2018) exhorted the PC(USA) to act boldly and compassionately to serve people who are hungry, oppressed, imprisoned or poor. Our adult Sunday school is currently suspended until further notice in light of the coronavirus outbreak, but participants are encouraged to continue reading the Matthew 25 devotional packets on their own.

## Lenten Banner Meaning

The symbol of the Lamb with the halo or nimbus signifies the lamb of Christ a member of the Trinity. The Cross is where the Lamb of God was sacrificed for the forgiveness of all sins. The lamb was a sacrificial animal. The color purple represents the sorrow and suffering of the Lenten season. The Words “Behold the Lamb of God” are how John the Baptist pointed to Jesus as the Lamb of God.
