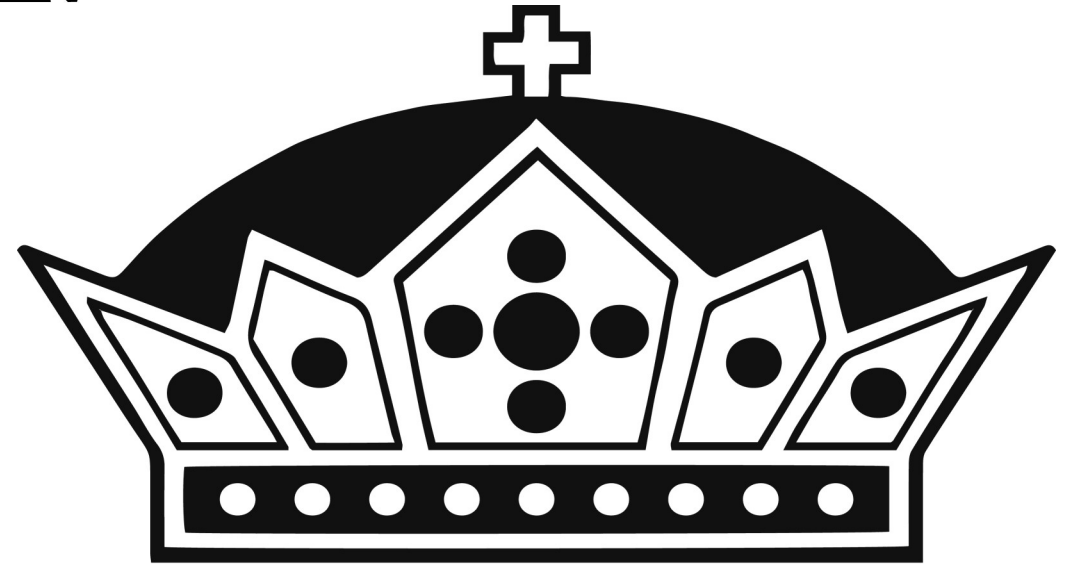
Hanging of the Greens: We will be meeting Tuesday, November 23rd at 10:00 am for the hanging of the greens. Please help if you can with this project.
